In addition, a student may read any number of other books either from the lists provided or from elsewhere. Because discussions and assignments will be based on the required book below, each student must have his or her own copy of the same edition with the same ISBN number (please see below). An objective test will be given on the common book along with a review of each of the other two books which will be worth 15 percent of the first quarter's English grade.
