

Dear Parents,

The season to secure your child's place in his or her class for next school year is now here. You may now choose from two ways to access the necessary forms:

During the first week of January 2012, the Admissions Office mailed home all the materials needed to secure your child(ren)'s place in his or her grade next year. If desired, you may download the 2012-2013 Registration Form from the CCA website ([www.christianca.com/Admissions/Registration/](http://www.christianca.com/Admissions/Registration/)).

Whatever means you use to access the form, please carefully read all the materials and instructions, complete and submit your re-registration form and fee (as soon as possible) to the Admissions Office. Forms and instructions – with important deadlines – will continue to be available in the Main Office, Admissions Office and on our website.

We have been receiving new student applications for several weeks and grades are beginning to fill up. Your timely re-registration is important for the faithful stewardship of all school resources.

Please remember that if you have another child not currently attending CCA but for whom you wish to pursue enrollment, while for convenience you may include that child's name on the registration form, you must also submit the Application for Admission and have the child move through the admission testing process before the registration will become valid.

Please note: Due to deadlines given to us for placing orders, textbooks for next school year will be available to new and returning students based upon the DATE we receive your paid registration. The later one re-registers, the less we can be sure that textbooks will arrive for your child before the school year begins.

Also, new students and their families are offered the opportunity to apply for admission to CCA, at all grade levels. **The next Open House is a two-part event and is scheduled for Monday, February 6, 2012 from 9:30 – 11:30 AM and for Tuesday, February 7, 2012, from 7 pm to 9 pm.** We want to be sure that you have secured your student(s)' place in his/her class.

Our entire faculty and staff are praying for every student, new or returning, who will be part of our school next fall. We pray that every member of our school community will grow "in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man." Thank you for submitting your re-registration in a timely manner and for encouraging your friends to consider Christian education at CCA.
