



This is your child's **KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST**. Please take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with what your child will need. These supplies should be brought to school **NO LATER THAN THE SECOND DAY OF SCHOOL**. Please feel free to bring some or all of these supplies with you when you attend the kindergarten parent informational meeting. Thank you for putting **your child's name on each item**. Crayons, markers and pencils should be **individually marked with initials** for quick identification. Thank you for all your time, effort and assistance in gathering and supplying these items.

1. 1 box of 24 count CRAYOLA crayons - We insist these be CRAYOLA crayons, so each child has consistent color names printed on each crayon for reading purposes. CRAYOLA crayons are also lead-free.
2. 1 pack of primary colored markers.
3. 1 -12 count (at least) colored pencils
4. 1 set of 12 count pencils- **please make sure that these are sharpened.**
5. 4 (.77 ounce) washable glue sticks
6. 1- 8 ounce ELMER's white glue bottle
7. 1 box of 100 count-5 ounce DIXIE cups
8. 1 - 200 count box of Kleenex tissues
9. 1 container of CLOROX disinfecting wipes-35 count
10. 1 pair of scissors-**please make sure your child can manipulate and cut with the scissors of your choice. They should be comfortable and work with ease.**
11. 1 water color paint set
12. 1 art smock
13. 1 rug or blanket ( no sleeping bags, please)
14. 1 school supply box **approx. 12x5 (2-3" deep) - STERILITE brand (11 1/2 x 7 x 2 3/4) works very well**
15. 1 sweater or sweatshirt (to be left at school)
16. 1 pair of extra sneakers (to be left at school for emergencies or if your child forgets his/her shoes)  
**Our gymnasium floor requires non-black athletic soled shoes.**
17. A COMPLETE CHANGE OF CLOTHES placed inside a large ZIPLOC bag and labeled "EXTRA CLOTHES FOR \_\_\_\_\_" This change of clothes does not need to follow dress code attire.
18. **\$5.50** for WEEKLY READER subscription for the year. **Please put this money in an envelope with your child's name and label it "WEEKLY READER"** .
19. 1-3 x 5 or 4 x 6 photo of your child
20. 1 school backpack/book bag (must be brought to school each day)
21. 1 folder for take home papers-This folder is an important line of communication between home and school. Your child must bring it to school each school day. **Please examine your child's work within the folder on a daily basis. This will allow the folder to remain clutter free.**
