

NEW KINDERGARTNERS:

To ensure the highest quality learning environment for your child, we will limit our total kindergarten enrollment to 34 students (2 classes of up to 17). Therefore, admissions applications for all incoming kindergarten students must be received by **Friday, March 30, 2012**. (Kindergarten applicants for the 2012-2013 school year must turn 5 years old by December 2012.)

Kindergarten entrance testing will be held Friday, May 4 and Saturday, May 5, 2012, to allow each applicant as much time as possible for growth and development before testing. Appointment date letters will be sent to applicant parents in mid-April.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

We are best able to reserve classroom space and give consideration for financial assistance only to families who demonstrate their commitment to Christian education and Christian Central Academy by first completing the admission application and/or registration form by the requested dates. **All admission applications and registration forms are available in the Main Office and the Admissions Office but are to be returned to the ADMISSIONS OFFICE only. All financial aid applications are available from and are to be returned to the BUSINESS OFFICE ONLY**, located at 25 School Street (blue house) during office hours or call 634-4821, ext 119.

FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION DEADLINE: Friday, February 10, 2012 – *Due in the Business Office for priority processing of currently enrolled CCA families. After February 10, processing is done on a rolling basis until all designated funds are exhausted.* **Reminder** – *no financial aid application will be considered unless there is already a paid registration form and/or new student application in process in the Admissions Office.*

BUS TRANSPORTATION REQUEST DEADLINE:

Monday, April 2, 2012 - **You** must contact your own district's transportation office to file **your** written request with them. Only exception – for students residing in the **Williamsville** (for K-12th graders) and **Buffalo** (for 9th-12th graders) districts, CCA will notify those districts' transportation offices to arrange your child's bus service **after** we have received your paid registration.

REGARDING REQUEST FOR ETHNICITY/RACIAL ORIGIN INFORMATION ON THE REGISTRATION FORM

Each school year the New York State Department of Education requests each non-public school to indicate the number of students from a wide spectrum of ethnic and racial groups represented in the total number of students enrolled. This is for statistical analysis only, and no names are ever divulged in this report. This information is collected to enable the State Education Department to administer the New York State Textbook Loan Program and to appropriate the proper amount of library, textbook and technology aid that will eventually come to CCA. While it is optional for you to indicate this information on your registration form, please know that if you do not, we must guess at the ethnicity and racial origin of your child(ren).

Directives given to us for this report indicate that "the racial/ethnic designations used in this item do not denote scientific definitions or anthropological origins. For the purpose of this report, a student should be included in the group to which he or she appears to belong, identifies with or is regarded in the community as belonging."
