- Mondays or Tuesdays anytime from 4:00 to 10:00 pm (\$122)
- Wednesdays or Thursdays anytime from 4:00 to 10:00 pm (\$127)
- Fridays or Saturdays anytime from 4:00 to 10:30 pm (\$175)

**Flexi Night (\$165)** - 8 nights beginning at 4 pm, 1 bonus day any day or night in March and April and 8 lessons.

**White Card (\$210)** - 9 non-holiday weekdays or any night, 1 bonus day any day or night in March and April and 8 lessons.

Lessons included with your pass are available at 5:30, 6:30, 7:30 pm every night. Sunday has an additional 4:00 pm lesson.  
Night lessons are November 25 (weather permitting) through March 9 at the base of the slope behind the Clubhouse Chalet.

When night skiing ends on March 17 (weather permitting), we are allowed to ski 8:30 am - 7:00 pm from March 18-24.

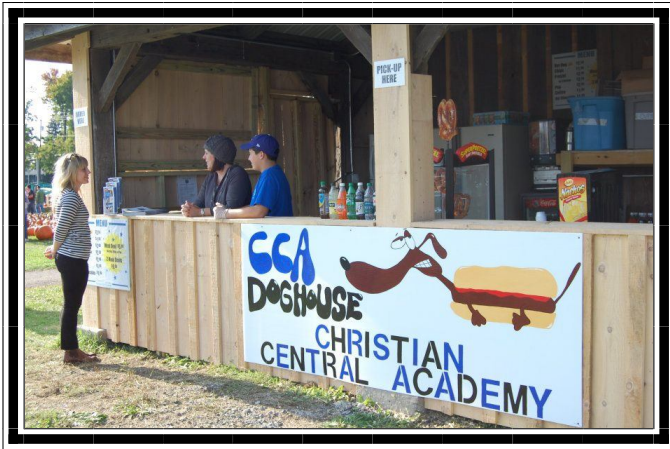
# NEW & IMPROVED PUMPKIN FARM!!

Re-Take Day is **THURSDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2011**. IF your child is sent for retake day, your packages will automatically be printed using the re-take image. IF YOUR CHILD DOES NOT SHOW UP FOR RE-TAKE DAY WE ARE GOING TO PROCESS YOUR ORDER USING THE IMAGES FROM OCTOBER 5. In the event that your child shows up on the absentee list on October 5, we will make other arrangements with you in the event that you do not care for your child's photo that will be taken on October 27.

After all photos are completed, we will process the images and pictures should be delivered to the school within three weeks.

Please note that the lower prices for packages 12, 13, 14, and 15 on the left side of the envelope are correct. The higher prices for those same packages on the right side of the envelope are incorrect.
