

STANDARDIZED MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

The Middle School teachers have implemented an organizational system for the students in hopes that this will aid them in keeping a neat locker, taking notes that are easy to carry home for studying, organizing homework, and beginning life-long organizational skills.

The teachers will begin the school year with instruction and guidance in how to organize and use the following supplies.

1 accordion expanding file - Please buy a sturdy one with a minimum of 12 file slots

8-10 composition notebooks - 100 sheet/ 200 page, wide ruled (Mead brand is preferred)
(more may be necessary as they become filled with notes)

Pocket Folders – must have a pocket on each side and prongs in the middle (see note concerning folders on the next page):

4 green (Science)	2 black paper or 1 plastic (Foreign Language for Gr.6 & 7 only)
4 purple (Math)	2 for Chorus (grade colors listed next page)
4 yellow (English)	1 orange (Health – Gr.8; Language – Gr.6)
4 red (Bible)	1 any color pocket folder (Art)
4 blue (Social Studies)

Green pens/pencils

Pencils

Filler Paper – wide-ruled

4 pack multi-color highlighters

Fiskar Scissors (6 inch)

Colored Pencils –8 pack Crayola

Small Container of Elmer’s Glue

NIV Bible

Scotch tape

Tissues

1 metal ring (2 inch)

Combination Lock (not key) - Master Lock recommended as bulky locks ruin lockers

No Spiral Notebooks and students should *not* bring white out to school.

Calculator – Gr. 6 & 7 may use a basic four function with square root key

Gr. 8 needs any scientific calculator (TI-84 Plus is used in Gr. 9)

Write-on Tabs (Self Stick Tabs – Heavy Duty Post-It Brand)

Pencil Case – durable & large enough to carry all supplies and calculator

Ruler – 6 inch with metric measures

Graph Paper – quad ruled

Index cards

Spanish – English Dictionary (Gr.7 & 8 only)

3-ring binder (2 inch) & 10 dividers (Gr.8 Spanish I students)

1 box #2 Ticonderoga pencils for art

3-ring binder (½-1 inch) with pockets (for Study Skills Gr. 7)

Grade 8 students Advanced Math and Science, will need to see the supply lists for Algebra and Earth Science.

Band: Standard of Excellence Book 2 (can be ordered from any music store) mechanical pencil, metronome and chromatic tuner (separate or combined).

Strings: Suzuki Book 2 with CD, mechanical pencil, and metronome with “A” Tuner (costs \$10-12 at most music stores). Instrument in proper working condition and awareness of care and accessories – rosin, shoulder rest, set of extra strings.

Art: **Grade 6 students, new students, and any student needing a new portfolio or sketch book:**

Students will need to bring \$13.50 to the Art teacher by the end of the 2nd week of school to cover the cost of sketch books (\$6.00) and portfolios – 20in. x 26 in. (\$7.50) which have already been purchased.

Technology: **Each student must have a 1 GB Flash Drive** on which to save all projects and class work done in school.
Please do not have siblings share Flash Drives.

Note concerning folders:

It is *possible* for students who purchase heavy-duty vinyl folders and are able to care for their materials carefully, to purchase only one folder for most subject areas, rather than the indicated four. At the end of each quarter they will simply take out all homework, tests, and quizzes and keep them at home to use for studying for midterms and finals, so that they can reuse the same folder. Other students, with the inexpensive paper folders, will be expected to take the entire folder home at the end of each quarter, put it in a safe place, and bring a new one to begin again the routine of organizing homework on one side and tests and quizzes on the other. This is important because students are often graded on how well they are following these procedures.

Students should **NOT** BRING ALL FOUR FOLDERS TO SCHOOL ON THE FIRST DAY. They only need one per subject area except in the following cases:

- Mrs. Kivett's Chorus 6- bring 2 blue folders w/ prongs & pockets
- Chorus 7- bring 2 green folders w/ prongs & pockets
- Chorus 8- bring 2 red folders w/ prongs & pockets

Grade 8 Advanced Students:

Algebra

- TI-84 Plus or TI-84 Plus Silver Edition Calculator
- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 purple folder with loose-leaf paper
- 1 package graph paper (quad $\frac{1}{4}$ in.)

Earth Science

- Same calculator as for Algebra
- Heavy duty green folder
- Composition notebook
- Mechanical pencils preferred
