


PROGRESS REPORTS: Grades K-2 "Progress Reports" will be mailed home to review your student's progress. Grades 3-12 "Progress Reports" will be published on Friday, October 7th for parents to see on CCA's portal. Review the attached instructions to view the reports. Please view these reports to check your student's progress. Each teacher should have a report posted for core classes. Academic probation begins the end of the first quarter. Progress Report grades can help you to see how your child is doing academically. Use this information to plan for the remainder of the quarter. Please know that Middle School & High School teachers provide after school review (schedule is posted on the portal) that may be highly recommended for some of the students who are struggling.

How to view Progress Reports Online

This year, CCA will be posting your student's progress reports right on the Portal! This way they can be accessed quickly and you don't need to worry about losing them. Just follow these steps below.

Note: Progress Reports will not be visible until all reports have been finalized by our faculty/staff.

1.) Access the CCA Portal by clicking on the CCA Portal link at the top right of the school's website





PSAT: All 10th & 11th graders are required to take the PSAT on Wednesday, October 12th. The cost is \$18. Please give your money to the Guidance Office before October 12th. Students should arrive at school no later than 8:00 am and report to the High School Library. Make sure to bring at least two number 2 pencils, a pen, and a calculator. 
Shepherding a Child's Heart Parenting Conference




