Health Office Hints



I am Rachel Schneiter, or Nurse Rachel to the littler ones. I have been nursing for 22 years, and this is my first year at CCA. Most recently, I have worked with expectant and new mothers, teaching them to care for their newborn babies. I love being a nurse and have been blessed to work with you to keep your beautiful kids healthy.

Let's Do What We Can

If you're looking for ways to stay healthy, you are not alone. Colds and illness cause us to miss out on so many important life events. Instead of focusing on avoiding all illness, it is easier to help your body avoid severe illness and poor outcomes. One way to stay healthy is to help your immune system by assuring sufficient vitamin D levels. If you are not already taking a vitamin D supplement, you should talk about this with your doctor. There is much evidence in recent years relating vitamin

D deficiency with increased illness, depressive symptoms, fatigue, muscle, joint pain among symptoms. Because it is difficult to get the needed amount of vitamin D through diet, supplements are necessary for most adults and children, especially those of us living in cold climates. Most of us can safely supplement with over the counter vitamin D during the months when we do not have much direct sun exposure. During summer months, being outdoors with skin exposed we can absorb sunlight and synthesize our own vitamin D.

As you already know, flu and cold season is upon us. Restrictions for returning to school following illness have relaxed much since last year. There is no testing requirement, but with any illness, a child must be fever free, without the benefit of Tylenol or Motrin, for 24 hours before returning.

If you have any questions about when your child is ok to return, or what would prohibit your child from attending, I welcome you to give us a call, 716-634-4821x104 or email healthoffice@christianca.com. If your child needs pain relievers or any medications to take at school, we can do this with both a doctor's order, and a note with permission from a parent

or guardian. Medications must be in the original prescription package or over the counter container. Orders can be faxed to 716-634-5851.
