




LOST AND FOUND



Is Everyone in Your Household Receiving Emails from CCA?

CCA relies primarily on email to send newsletters and other information to families. Some of these emails may be extremely important and time sensitive. Please be sure that you have whitelisted any email addresses with the following address domains so you don't miss important communication from us.

It is always good practice to check your junk/spam/clutter folder for any emails that may have been incorrectly flagged.

If you are a parent or guardian and are not receiving our emails, please follow these steps:

- 1. Check your junk, spam and clutter folders for the email.
- 2. If you find the email in one of those folders, be sure to mark it as a "safe sender" or "not spam". This will prevent future emails from us from being marked as spam.

Health Office Hints

Thank you to all the parents that are either emailing or calling in to notify us about student absences or late arrivals. It is a state requirement to account for each day a child is not in attendance. Notification saves the nurses from calling each family to find out why the child is absent. Emailing is most convenient for you as it can be done any time day or night, attendance@christianca.com

I also wanted to make parents aware that we are seeing *increased numbers of Strep infections* in our student population. Strep A is a bacteria often found to infect the skin and throat. It is treated with antibiotics. Skin infections from Strep A are called Impetigo and are less serious, but still require treatment. I want you to be aware of **symptoms of Strep** to seek treatment for your child and prevent serious complications. Some common symptoms are:

- -sore throat, especially painful with swallowing
- -red and swollen tonsils, sometimes with patches or pus
- -swollen lymph nodes on neck
- -sandpaper-like rash or peeling of skin

- -fever of 101 or higher
- -red spots on roof of mouth
- -headache, stomachache, nausea or vomiting
- -rash on face, trunk, arms or legs,

known as Scarlet Fever

As with any illness, passing the contagious part is only half of what constitutes readiness to return to school. If your child is still weak and unable to perform desk work, it would be best to let them rest a bit longer.

The district nurse has begun Health Screenings for students in the required grades K,1,3 and 5. You will receive written notification if your child's screen is out of the norm, which would just involve follow up with their primary care doctor.

I am excited to tell you that a number of faculty and staff participated in AED, Choking and CPR certification last Saturday. We currently have 2 AED's on campus and are hoping to acquire more. There's an *immediate ask* for 2 portable ones that could travel with students to games.


