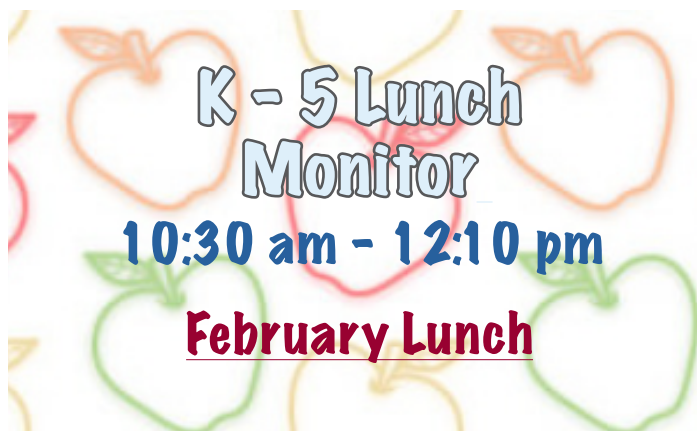

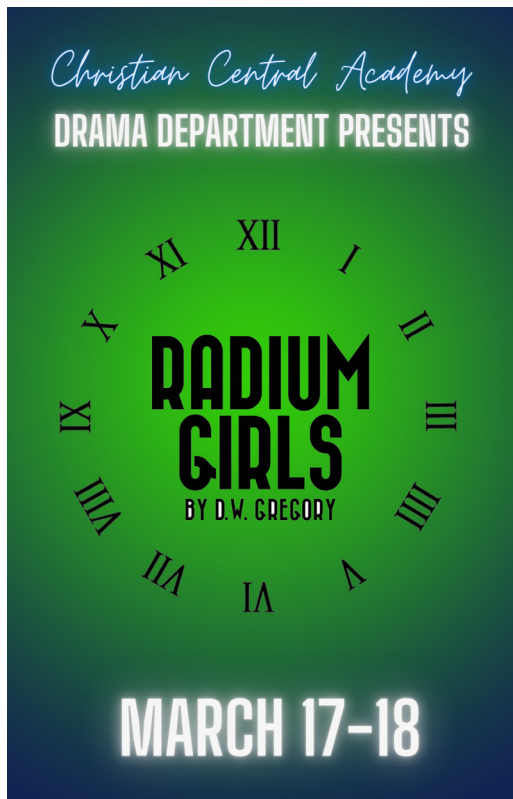

If you are a parent or guardian and are not receiving our emails, please follow these steps:

Health Office Hints

Thank you to all parents who email or call the main office to notify us about student absences or late arrivals. It is a state requirement to account for each day a child is not in attendance. Notification saves the nurses from calling each family to find out why the child is absent. Email may be most convenient for you, as it can be done any time day or night to attendance@christianca.com

Check last week's WAAG for detailed symptoms of Strep Infections (Strep A), as we have seen cases on the rise.

As with any illness, passing the contagious part is only half of what constitutes readiness to return to school. If your child is still weak and unable to perform desk work, *it would be best to let the child rest a bit longer.*

The district nurse has begun Health Screenings for students in the required grades K,1,3 and 5. *You will receive written notification if your child's screen is out of the norm, which would just involve follow up with your child's primary care doctor.*

We currently have 2 AEDs on campus. **PRAISE THE LORD** for a donation of 2 additional AEDs, one to travel with students to games and one for the Center for Science and Arts.
