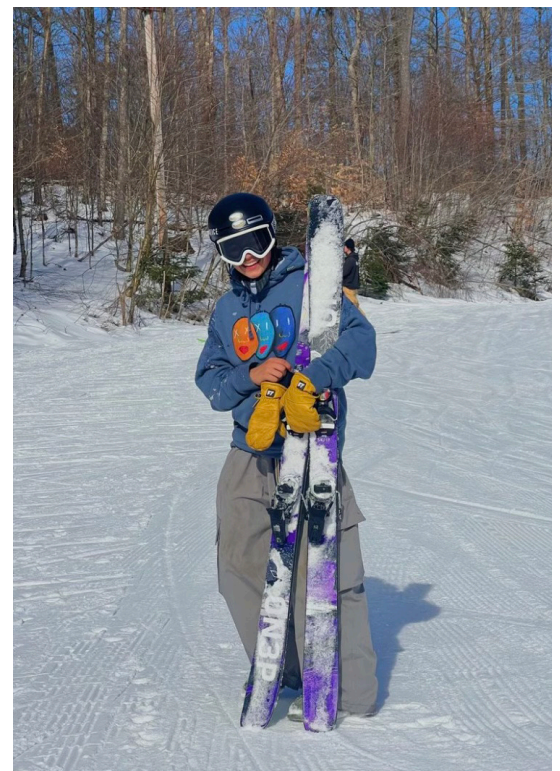
Occupationally, I am the Northeast Sales Manager of VEGA Americas and lead a team of 12 people in the industrial automation space.

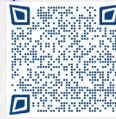



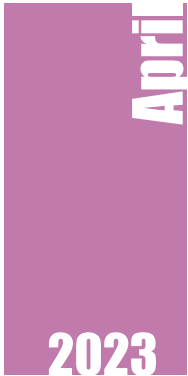
