



#### **Health Office Hints**

#### A couple of Health Office reminders for April:

We are not permitted to dispense any medications, even things like Tylenol, without both a doctor's order and written parental permission. If your child is prone to conditions requiring pain relievers etc. during the school day, your doctor may fax an order to the Health Office at (716)-634-5851. You may send a note in as your written permission, or send an email to healthoffice@christianca.com

As we slowly close out winter, illnesses are thankfully fewer. CCA continues to have episodes of viral illnesses and Strep infections in our student population. See below for Strep facts. Teachers are working to remind students to wash hands before snacks and meals, and doing an entry wash in the morning in rooms with shared toys and activities.

Strep A is a bacteria often found to infect the skin and throat. It is treated with antibiotics. Skin infections from Strep A are called Impetigo and are less serious, but still require treatment.

I want you to be aware of symptoms of Strep to seek treatment for your child and prevent serious complications.

#### Some common symptoms are:

- -sore throat, especially painful with swallowing
- -headache
- -nausea or vomiting
- -red spots on roof of mouth
- -sandpaper-like rash or peeling of skin
- -red and swollen tonsils, sometimes with patches or pus
- -rash on face, trunk, arms or legs, also known as Scarlet Fever
- -stomachache
- -fever of 101 or higher
- -swollen lymph nodes on neck

I am in the Health Office Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays if you have any questions. I hope that your family has a healthy and blessed Easter break.






